

Advanced Four Winds and Minesweeper – Division C Round 5 2020-2021

Variants Instruction Booklet and Examples (Four Winds only)

You will time all of your puzzles separately, like Division D. There will be a selection of standard versions of each type, and one of each of the following variants.

Four Winds

Empty Squares Four Winds – this has standard Four Winds rules, but note that not all cells will contain lines in this puzzle.

Walls – Fill all cells with either a horizontal or vertical wall such that the clues indicate the length of walls connected to the clue cell.

Eight Winds – Similar to Four Winds, but lines may go diagonally or horizontal or vertical, so in eight possible directions.

Liar Four Winds - Standard Four Winds rules. However, all given clues are one away from their true value. Note that all squares in this grid must be filled

Hex Winds – Similar to Four Winds, but on a hexagonal grid. Winds can go in any of the six directions suggested by the sides of the hexagons.

Octo Winds – Similar to Four Winds, but on an octagons and squares grid. Winds can go in any of the eight directions suggested by the sides of the octagons, or the four directions suggested by the sides of the squares.

Mix

Four Winds and Minesweeper – Unshaded clues are Four Winds clues. Shaded clues are Minesweeper clues. Cells must be filled with either winds or mines to satisfy all clues.

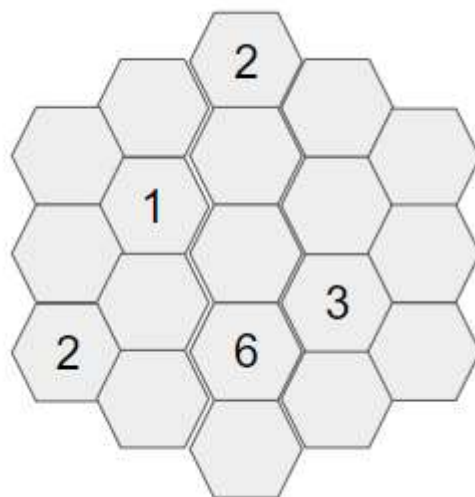

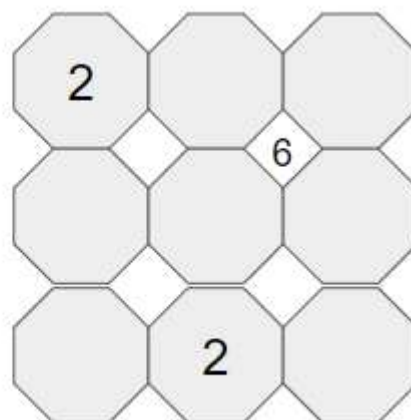
