Puzzles by Adam Bissett

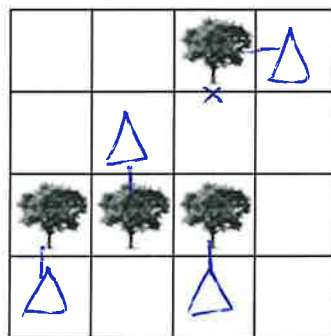
